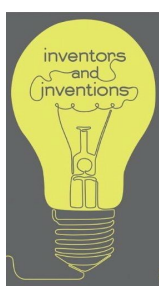




SPIRIT WEEK UPDATE

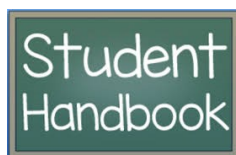
\$500 TUITION CREDIT
