Beginning today, families are able to access Sign-Up Genius [here](#) to register for a time slot to deliver school supplies, pick up textbooks, and set up lockers on either Friday, August 21, or Monday, August 24. Check out the information below for more information.

All students (Early Ed-12th grade):

Drop off:

- School supplies (Kleenex, sanitizer, bandaids, antibacterial wipes, & baby wipes will be collected in the front hallway). All other school supplies will be placed on desks in classrooms (EE-1st grade) or put in lockers (2nd-12th grade).
- Medication/Medical Forms
- Car information-make, model and license plate number (students driving to school)

Pick up:

- Car signs for dismissal (EE-8th grade)
- Textbooks (6th-12th grade)

2nd-12th Grade Students Only:

Please put all school supplies in your locker and set up/decorate your locker during this time. Be sure to check FACTS (available on Monday, August 17th) in order to know your locker assignment.



If you are unable to attend one of these days, school supplies should be brought on the first day of school and textbooks will be placed in student lockers. Just a reminder that masks must be worn inside during these days.

LUNCHES

We will begin serving catered lunches Tuesday, September 8. All lunches must be ordered in advance through ParentsWeb (FACTS). The 15th of each month is the last day to order lunches for the month immediately following. However, for your convenience, ordering for September lunches is extended until Wednesday, August 26, and will be available beginning Monday, August 17. Wednesday: Meatheads Double Header! Choose between two entrees:


- Grilled cheese sandwich, homemade chips, applesauce, & water \$5.50

EXTENDED CARE

Before School Care will be available beginning the first day of school (Wednesday, August 26) for all students. Beginning at 7:15 AM, students may be dropped off at the front entrance where they will be greeted by a CCA staff member, and signed in, recording their time of arrival. All Early Ed through 12th grade students coming prior to 8:00 AM must be signed into Before School Care and report to the designated locations. Early Ed-5th grade students will be directed or escorted to assigned rooms. Junior high and high school students (6th-12th grade) must go directly to the Forum Room after they gather necessary items from their lockers. Upper school students are not invoiced for BSC. Students will not be allowed to wait in the airlock or congregate in the hallways before school begins.

After School Care will also begin on August 26. Any Early Ed—8th grade student not picked up by 3:30 PM will be escorted to ASC. When parents arrive to pick up children from ASC, they should display their family name card in the passenger side window, pull into the circle drive on the north side of the school building near the main entrance, and call the phone number displayed on the sign located near the driveway to notify ASC personnel of their arrival. A member of the ASC team will sign the student out of ASC and will escort the student to their vehicle.
