- Please do not park in the first six (6) spaces on the south edge of the lot until **AFTER 3:30 PM**.

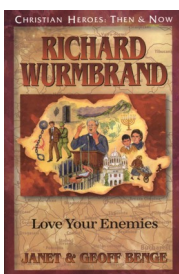

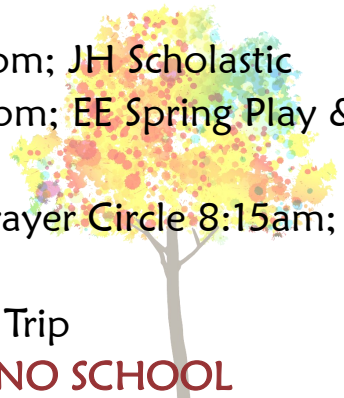
