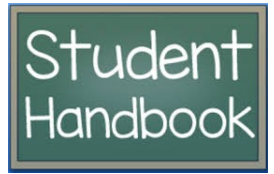
SAVE \$\$ ORDERING LUNCHES!

If you order lunches, you know there is 3.75% fee charged by debit and credit card companies. However, if you pay for your lunches via an EFT (ACH), which comes directly from your checking or savings account, there is only a **single fee of \$0.85 per transaction** regardless of the total amount!

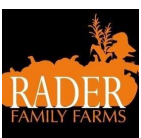
