Join the 2nd grade class for the annual presentation of Colonial Days **Monday, March 16th at 2 pm** in the gym.



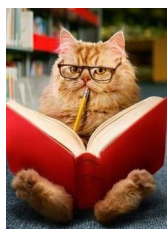
