PARKING LOT REMINDERS

For the safety and efficiency of our morning drop-off routine, please adhere to the following guidelines: • Pull up to the northernmost stopping point (colored pylons to the north of the crosswalk).

• Be sure students are prepared to exit the vehicles. If your child requires your assistance with coats, backpacks, lunch boxes, instruments, etc., please park in a parking spot, and we will escort him/her across the crosswalk. Drivers should not exit vehicles in the drop-off lane.

 \cdot All students should unload through the passenger side doors.

 \cdot Never pass a stopped vehicle in the drop-off area, unless directed to do so by school personnel.
