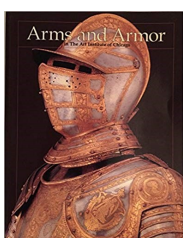
## YEARBOOKS

## SEMESTER TUITION

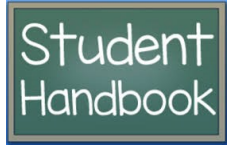
