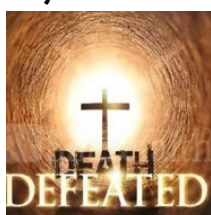
SPIRIT WEEK

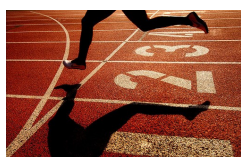

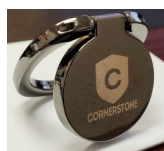
